

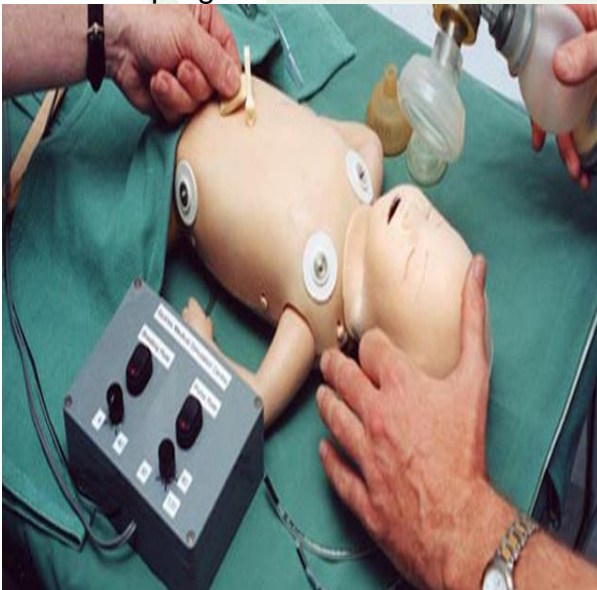
## AIMSi Presents CMS' Institute for Medical Simulation Instructor Training Course, "Simulation as a Teaching Tool"
